Design and Purpose

This training is designed to support those with management/supervisory experience by creating an environment for networking and cross-mentoring to foster long-term relationships of support.

Leadership Assessment

The core of the academy is the 360 degree leadership assessment of each individual participant and understanding its impact on the functioning of the CAC.

Participants will be required to complete four pre-course instruments to be submitted in advance of the course.

Professional Coaching

Participants will have an opportunity to meet one-on-one with a Professional Coach to receive input and guidance on their individual leadership styles. Professional Coaching allows participants to work on advancing their individual skills developed in a group setting through an offering of one-on-one coaching.

Exciting New Opportunity!

Extended Executive Coaching

Extended Executive Coaching is being offered for the first time. Upon approval of funding by the participant's Regional CAC, participants will be provided with up to 2 months of additional telephone coaching after the Academy. A firm commitment from the participant to schedule and keep appointments will be required.

Your coach will work with you to sustain effective behaviors, manage complex situations, manage relationships and lead change. Coaching is a confidential program. If funding is not available from the RCAC or for additional sessions, participants may contract directly with the coach.
