# FOCUS OF TRAINING

The intersection of law and medical can be quite challenging and, at times daunting for both professionals. In child abuse cases, navigating this uncomfortable territory is the rule rather than the exception. Medical care providers are often anxious about going to court and frequently feel ill prepared. Attorneys are often faced with the interpretation of specialized medical data, obfuscating expert witnesses and inaccessible medical providers. By combining medical and legal faculty in an exciting new training, we hope to address these concerns.

The focus of this training will be primarily on sexual abuse cases. Only non-emergent physical abuse will be covered. This training is especially intended for mid-level providers (Pediatric SANE, P.A., C.N.P.) and any physician in a CAC setting.

# TOPICS

Role of the Medical Provider, abusive head, abdominal and cutaneous traumas, guidelines and standards of care for possible SA victims, genital findings, testifying as a medical expert, hearsay, memory and suggestibility and an actual mock trial for the medical professionals.

The legal training will consist of trial tactics, ethical considerations, direct and cross examination of witnesses, preparing children for court, the role of the medical provider, abusive head, abdominal and cutaneous trauma, child sexual abuse, hearsay and a mock trial.
