This month a child was seriously abused by his father and passed away due to the abuse. Two of the victim's siblings were witnesses to this tragedy. After the incident the aunt of the children, 'Sarah', took the siblings into her care, and brought them to Safe Passage for forensic interviews. When Sarah met the team involved with the case for the first time, she was surprised about how many people were in the room- 2 detectives, 2 DHS caseworkers, 2 DA investigators, 2 Safe Passage interviewers, and a Safe Passage advocate.

Both children were interviewed while the advocate met with Sarah. Sarah asked a lot of great questions, starting with "What is this place?". The advocate explained what Safe Passage, a Children's Advocacy Center is, and how the model of care helps children, families and all team partners involved by ensuring that a child does not have to be interviewed repeatedly by all different agency's involved.

After the interviews were completed, Sarah had time to ask further questions and receive referrals for other services, including mental health counseling for the children. She expressed her gratitude that Safe Passage was such a welcoming place for the children and shared that even with "all of this COVID stuff" going on she felt like her family was getting every bit of support they could have hoped for from all of the professionals involved that day at Safe Passage.

This is the beauty of the the model of care that Safe Passage provides! We surround families in the midst of tragedy and offer hope and healing through holistic services and care while taking actionable steps towards justice.
